Optimal Health Diabetes Top Up Program



The Logan-Beaudesert Placed Based Initiative has recognized that due to the low socio-economics of the region, financial support to patients with chronic disease is warranted as the waiting period for Allied Health Services within the public sector is inappropriate for effective health care delivery. The brokerage component of the initiative is targeting the chronic disease of diabetes. GPs can refer patients to the Top Up Program.

Objective:

To provide financial assistance to patients with diabetes who are eligible to access additional Allied Health services through Team Care Arrangements (TCA).

What is it?

- 5 additional Allied Health Professional (AHP) consultations available after TCA review.

Eligibility:

- The patient is receiving treatment for diabetes, and
- The GP has a TCA in place, and
- The patient requires one of the following Allied Health Services*: Dietitian, Podiatrist, Exercise Physiologist, Physiotherapist and Occupational Therapist.

*AHP must work within South East Primary Health Care Network Area.

How does it work?

- GP conducts a review of TCA and refers patient on to desired AHP.
- GPs charge TCA Review as per Medicare (727).
- AHP fulfills referral requirements.
- AHP faxes invoice and a copy of correspondence with GP for consultations provided under Optimal Health Diabetes Top Up Program to SPHN
- SPHN reimburses AHP.
