## Eyesight and Depression

Vision Australia and the Centre for Eye Research Australia are working together to trial a new depression screening and referral system. Vision Australia staff will use a short depression screening tool (PHQ2) with clients they suspect may be depressed.

For those clients who screen positive, a referral to their General Practitioner (GP) is offered, in addition to emotional support options at Vision Australia. With consent, a written letter outlining the screening test result will be sent to the client's GP. Where a client does not have their own GP, one will be identified (via AGPN) that best suits the client's locality.
