

Human swine influenza vaccine (Panvax H1N1) and Seasonal influenza vaccine in children under the age of 10 years

If your child is **not having** seasonal flu vaccine – two doses of Panvax® H1N1 at least 28 days apart.

If your child **is having** seasonal flu vaccination, the number of doses depends on whether he/she has had seasonal flu vaccination before:

Child has *never* had seasonal flu vaccination but had two doses of Panvax:

Seasonal + Seasonal

(At least 28 days between each dose)

Child had seasonal flu vaccination (2 doses in the same year) before but no Panvax:

Panvax + Seasonal **or** Seasonal + Panvax **or** Seasonal + Seasonal

(At least 28 days between each dose)

Child has had one seasonal flu vaccination in the past and one Panvax:

Seasonal + Seasonal

(At least 28 days between each dose)

Eligibility for free vaccine:

- Panvax® H1N1 is available free to all (GPs may charge a consultation fee)
- Seasonal influenza vaccine is only free for eligible groups (see “Annual Seasonal Funded Influenza Program” flyer) but can be purchased with a private script.

What dosage is required?

Age	Dose
6 months - <3 years	0.25 mL
3 - < 10 years	0.5 mL
10 years & over	0.5 mL
